Early permanence





Early permanence involves children being placed with potential adoptive parents who are also approved as temporary foster carers while the court decides about the child's future.

This gives crucial stability and continuity of care as early as possible to babies and young children who are very likely to be adopted.

PACT needs more people who could consider early permanence and will support families throughout, offering:

- Social workers specially trained in early permanence plus your own early permanence carer buddy
- Support when meeting birth families and specialised grief and loss support, if the child returns to their birth family
